Students working with animal subjects need to read the booklet, complete the form associated with the Animal Contact program, and enclose a copy of the appropriate form. Students working with human participants may need to obtain approval of the Institutional Review Board. Students who come in contact with human pathogens must comply with the blood-borne pathogens program (e.g., hepatitis B shots). Check with your faculty sponsor about these regulations.
